Introduction to A358 Improvements

The existing A358 between Taunton and Southfields is a mix of dual and single carriageway. Where two lanes merge into one, these bottlenecks lead to delays and uncertain journey times.

The scheme objectives are to relieve congestion, support economic growth and improve safety on one of the busiest stretches of the A303/A358.

The Government's Road Investment Strategy: 2015/16 to 2019/20 sets out the intention to transform connectivity between London and the south east and the south west by improving the route from the M3 motorway to the M5 at Taunton.

To support this, we are developing three major road improvement schemes along the A303/A358 corridor:

- A358 Taunton to Southfields
- · A303 Sparkford to Ilchester
- · A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down
